RESEARCH

My research to date has been in three overlapping areas. These are sociological research on grassroots community initiatives and interventions, research on urban processes in extended urban areas and global knowledge transfer. As a part of the MAS Urban Design program at ETH Zurich, my research on the *Minha Cassa, Nossa Cidade* mass housing program in Rio de Janeiro and the study of popular architecture from Brazil, the *Arquitetura Popular Brasileira* was published through the book *My Home, My City (Minha Cassa, Nossa Cidade!)* and exhibited at the Studio X in Rio de Janeiro and at the Sao Paolo Architecture Biennale. The research mobilised a much needed debate around the nature of mass housing in Brazil. Through managing the Urban Age Award in 2014 and producing a mapping and archive of grassroots urban initiatives in Delhi, I created a unique database on bottom-up resilience in the city. This was published as a report, Deutsche Bank Urban Age Award 2014 Delhi and later developed into the 'Urbanxchanger' project through which a global knowledge transfer was experimented between the south-south and the north-south contexts. Through the project, teams of urban practitioners from Delhi, Sao Paolo, Mexico City, Cape Town and Berlin worked on community initiatives in these cities. The knowledge from the project was shared through public discussions in Berlin and Delhi and published as a book 'Urbanxchanger: Co-designing the City', it was also exhibited at the LSE Cities special pavilion at the Venice Biennale 2016. I have parallelly been working with the NGO, CURE in the peri-urban communities of Delhi, doing applied research through skill based livelihood development. In 2015, I conducted research on extended urbanisation in Asian cities through my work at the Future Cities Lab and teaching at the School of Planning and Architecture in Delhi. Through my work, I have been experimenting with participatory GIS platforms and how these can be used to study Circular Urbanisation in Delhi's extended urban region.
